Apparently, it's been going really well and Ernie's recall is 'excellent' – he always comes running straight back to Sheila when called. Ernie always slows down before approaching Sheila so as not to knock her over by accident, and sits dutifully in front of her so she can put his lead back on. Well done, Ernie!

To get to all the places they've been to over the last couple of months, Sheila has taken Ernie on buses and trains to get him used to public transport.
